Innovative and low carbon mobility in Sint-Amands, on the riverbank of the Scheldt

What challenge or problem are you addressing? What is the need for the project?

New developments concerning the restoration and accessibility of rural heritage (a historical farm, a windmill annex information centre and museum, ...), close to the Scheldt-riverbank in the community of Sint-Amands, provide the opportunity to attract more tourists and enliven this isolated area, far from the conventional transport hubs. New forms of innovative and low carbon transportation, integrated in the economy and culture of the local community, are needed to improve the viability and biodiversity of this rural area.

Objective of the project:

The project wants to explore the development, testing and implementation of innovative and low carbon means of transportation in accordance with the needs of the local community and improving biodiversity.

Why do you need transnational cooperation?

The development of durable means of transportation to improve the accessibility of and mobility within isolated rural areas, provides an answer to a common goal in NW Europe. Experimenting in different areas and on different levels leads to a catalogue of best practices, facilitating and stimulating the implementation of similar projects on a regional, national and transnational level.
