Objective of the project:

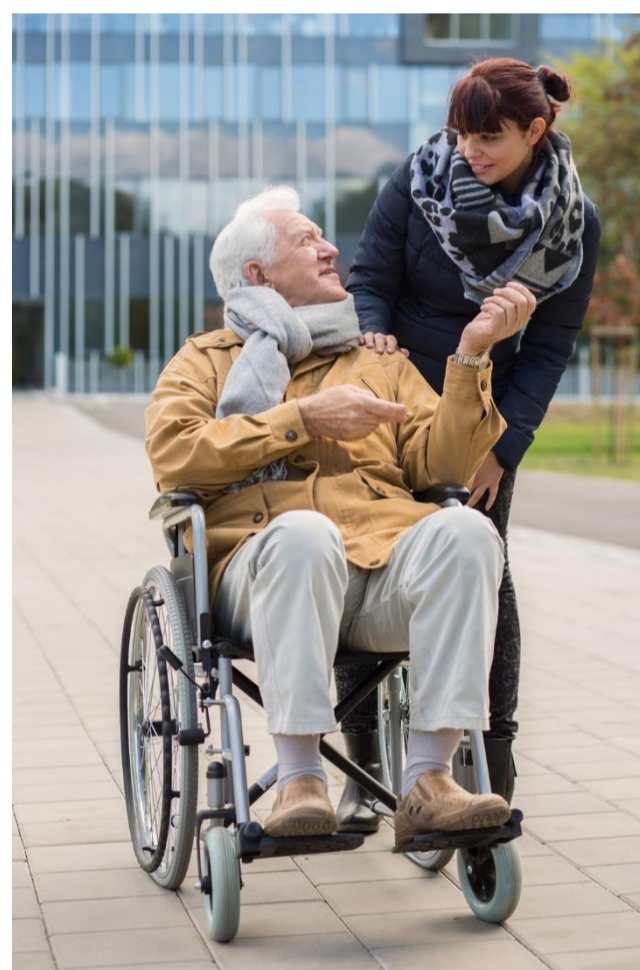
To improve the mobility situation of elderly and mobility challenged people by accompanying services in public transport. IT support allows to offer this service in a scalable and economically viable manner.
